

Bitwig Setup and Functional Overview

The Pacer Bitwig integration has been verified from Bitwig 8-Track and Bitwig Studio 1.0 and 2.0 or higher.

These instructions assumes you have a compatible Bitwig program installed running on either Windows (Vista, 7, 8, 10 or higher) or Mac OS X 10.7 or higher.

Installation

- Complete the Pacer firmware update available in a separate download under your product registration.
- If you have just completed a fresh install of Bitwig, make sure to first open Bitwig once and quit again.
- Locate the Pacer_Bitwig_support installer included with the downloaded package and run it.
- Plug-in your Pacer and make sure it's switched on.
- Launch Bitwig and go to Options/Preferences/Controllers.
- Click "Detect available controllers". Pacer should now appear in the list. Click "Ok" and exit Device Setup.
- If you are using Bitwig Studio 2.0, Pacer is automatically detected so just click "Add" when you see the notification.

That's it, setup is now complete and you can move on to the fun part, learning how it all works

Long-Press Functions

Pressing and holding the Transport switch assigns switches 1-6 to long press functions as per the below chart.
